Week One - June 24 to June 29

Little Musician

For a Child's Brain, Body, Heart and Soul. Music is powerful. It can excite, energize, calm and comfort. In the Little Musician program, children experience music of varying styles, genres and cultures. They interact with other children and engage in movement, rhythm and vocal activities that develop far more than just music skills. Campers will also have the opportunity to produce simple music and learn notes by using different musical instruments.

Week Three – July 8 to July 12

Sportball

Five days of indoor and outdoor Sportball programs focuses on non-competitive, skill based games and activities to support their motor and social development. Each child is encouraged to progress at his or her own pace, and children who refine, rehearse and repeat their skills often show a marked difference in their development.



Week Four – July 15 to July 19

Kindergarten Stem



Stem is the integration (not singular practice) of Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math in an active environment that focuses on student-centered learning. Campers are engaged in the discovering of problems, questioning, problem solving, collaborating, and hands on activities while they face real world issues.

On Tuesday, July 16, Tinker Truck will bring a Summer Portable River to our outdoor playground. Campers can design their own boats out of popsicle sticks, corks, foam bricks and elastics, and then send them down the river.

Week Five – July 22 to July 26

Travel Around The World

Campers will be building their own private jets and travel around the world to explore the history of different nations, their culture, point of interest in each country, types of food, clothing, landmarks.....

Animal Kingdom



Discover the world of animals; life cycles, families, habitats, food chains.....

Eco Kids

Campers will have the opportunity to learn about how we can individually do our part to protect our beautiful planet earth; through a variety of interesting and interactive eco-themed lessons and games.

Earthbound Kids Workshop on August 7

Building Blocks of Compost

This workshop involves a scavenger game between the “greens” and the “browns”. First, we will help the students sort through the classroom’s waste. Next, we will look at what can be re-cycled, re-used and composted. Then, food waste is sorted by colour & texture – separating items into smooth, rough, browns & greens and exploring the hows and whys of composting AND why it is so important for building healthy soil.



Worm Power

The second part of our Compost workshop involves learning about Vermicomposting: using worms to speed up the composting process. Students will have the opportunity to create their own worm hotel. After building their worm hotel, students will be encouraged to use their own snack wastes to power the hotel. By early spring you'll have worm castings (poop) to nourish your school gardens.

All About Seeds

Learn about the power of seeds and how they contain everything for the growth and development of a new plant. Students will make seedling trays with newspaper and plant bean seeds using the worm castings from the classroom vermicompost.

Week Eight – August 12 to August 16

Monkeynastix



Monkeynastix is a fun and challenging fitness movement education program that focuses on the development of physical literacy in children from ages 1 to 8 years. The program's focus is on developing children's fundamental movement skills (gymnastic) and works on the long term, physical, cognitive, and social development of children.
